To kill centipedes, firebrats, silverfish, sowbugs and spiders: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Also, thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators.

To kill brown dog ticks and fleas: Remove and destroy old pet bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks and localized areas of floors. Repeat as necessary. DO NOT SPRAY ANIMALS. Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Treat animals with a registered flea and tick control product before allowing them to re-enter treated areas.

FOR CRACKS AND CREVICES [Attach extension tube to spray tip]

To kill ants, brown dog ticks, carpet beetles, cockroaches, crickets, fleas, silverfish, sowbugs, and spiders: Apply spray in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices where these pests hide.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area, away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Shake well before using. Hold container upright. Apply in short bursts.

In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly washed before use. Cover exposed food, dishes and food handling equipment. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

FOR SPACE SPRAY

To kill flies, gnats, mosquitoes, small flying moths and wasps: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average size room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Before spraying, cover exposed food and utensils. Ventilate treated area before re-entry.

FOR SPOT TREATMENT

To kill ants, cockroaches and crickets: Spray all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Spray cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ants, treat doors, around window frames, ant trails and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

To kill exposed forms of confused flour beetles, rice weevils and saw-toothed grain beetles: Find and destroy infested package goods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves have dried. Repeat as necessary.
