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BACK PANEL

IMPORTANT: TO AVOID DAMAGE OR POOR RESULTS, CAREFULLY READ AND FOLLOW ALL DIRECTIONS AND PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Shake well before using. Hold container upright. Apply in short bursts. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Cover exposed dishes and food handling equipment. Before spraying, exposed food should be covered or removed.

INDOORS:

To kill flies, gnats, mosquitoes and small flying moths: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average size room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Sweep up and discard fallen insects.

To kill ants, centipedes, cockroaches, crickets, firebrats, sowbugs and spiders: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thoroughly spraying all pads of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas, and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ants, treat doors, around window frames, ant trails and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

To kill carpet beetles: Directly spray as many insects as possible. Spray both interior and • exterior of upholstered furniture. Both top and bottom of rugs and carpets should be thoroughly sprayed. Also treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture and wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.

To kill exposed forms of confused flour beetles, rice weevils and saw-toothed grain beetles: Find and destroy infested package goods. Remove all other items from pantry.

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Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves have dried. Repeat as necessary.

To kill fleas and ticks in pet bedding and pet areas: Remove and destroy pet's old bedding. To reduce infestation, thoroughly spray the animal's sleeping quarters, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, localized areas of floors and other resting places until the surface is slightly moist. Treat these areas at the rate of two seconds per linear foot at a distance of 12 to 18 inches. Also spray the entire inside surface of dog houses. Repeat as necessary. Put fresh bedding in pet's quarters after spray has dried. DO NOT SPRAY ANIMALS. Treat animals with a registered flea and tick control product before allowing them to re-enter treated areas.

To treat flea and tick infestation in rugs and carpets: Spray rugs and carpets where fleas tend to hide. If used on light or delicate upholstery fabrics, test for potential staining in an inconspicuous place prior to use. Spray thoroughly into hiding places such as crack and crevices in walls and floors, along baseboards, and window and door frames. Spray at the rate of one square foot per second. Repeat as necessary.

OUTDOORS:

To kill flies, gnats, mosquitoes and small flying moths: Spray area infested with these flying insects. Hold container 18-24 inches from shrubs, bushes and grassy areas. Spray these areas with a slow sweeping motion at a rate of 1 to 3 seconds per cubic yard of space while moving away from the treated area. To reduce annoyance from these pests, treat open porches and patios in a similar manner. Spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the treatment area.

Home Gardens: For use on ornamental plants around the home. Do not use on edible crops. When spraying directly on insects, this spray will kill Eastern Tent Caterpillars, Aphids, Cankerworms, Leafhoppers, White Flies, Spider Mites, Japanese Beetles, Mealybugs, Ants, Caterpillars, and Box Elder Bugs on Ornamental Cherry, Spirea, Roses, Crepe Myrtle, Ornamental Crabapple, Andromeda, Azalea, Chrysanthemum, Gardenia, Purple Passion Vine, Peony, Oleander, and Arborvitae. Caution should be used when spraying tender growth on young plants. WHEN SPRAYING, HOLD CAN 18-20 INCHES FROM THE PLANT. For best results, spray in the evening or on a cloudy day when air is still. Mist the plants lightly. Use a slow sweeping motion. Avoid wetting foliage with spray. Spray rows at a rate of 1 foot per second. For heavy growth, spray both sides of row. Repeat as needed. Do not spray when temperature exceeds 90°F.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area, away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
