directions appearing under outdoor use for controlling these insects.

e. Under **To kill fleas, ticks, and lice on dogs:** change "lass" to "less".

f. Under Directions for Use delete the section beginning "Animal Quarters" and "To control blood sucking lice". These directions are for livestock and their premises, not household use.". Likewise change "Animal Treatment" to "Dog Treatment".

g. Under FOR USE ON PLANTS: delete "spider mites".

h. Under FOR USE ON PLANTS: change "short bursts" to "one second bursts".

i. Change "For Use on Plants" to "For Use on Ornamental/Plants (flowers, shrubbery and trees)".

j. Under **PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS** change "Avoid contact...until spray has dried with "Harmful if inhaled. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. Remove contaminated clothing before reuse. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Remove pets and cover fish aquaria before spraying. Vacate room after treatment and ventilate before reoccupying. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated areas until surfaces are dry.".

k. Under **STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT If inhaled:** change "Apply artificial respiration if indicated." to read "If not breathing give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth. Get medical attention.".

l. Under Physical or Chemical Hazards add "Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.".

m. Revise the back panel statement to read "For Use In And Around The Home Only" and relocate to the front panel.

3. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

BACK PANEL

IMPORTANT: TO AVOID DAMAGE OR POOR RESULTS, CAREFULLY READ AND FOLLOW ALL DIRECTIONS AND PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. FOR USE AROUND THE HOME ONLY.

In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquaria before spraying.

Shake well before using. Do not use on surfaces that can be harmed or stained by water. Remove protective cap, hold container upright, and aim spray away from face and body.

INDOORS

AS A SURFACE SPRAY:

To kill cockroaches, waterbugs, palmetto bugs, crickets, silverfish, firebrats, millipedes, centipedes, sowbugs (pillbugs), spiders and scorpions: Spray into hiding places such as cracks, crevices, behind sinks, cabinets, along baseboards and floors, around drains and plumbing, hitting insects with spray whenever possible. Repeat as necessary.

To kill ants: Spray trails, nests and points of entry within homes and buildings. Spray directly on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

To kill wasps, hornets, yellow jackets and bees: Use in late evening or early morning when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, especially under attic rafters, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.

To kill carpet beetles: Spray directly on beetles, floors, baseboards, shelves and carpets. Repeat as necessary.

To kill bedbugs: Spray mattresses, particularly around tufts and seams. Take beds apart and spray all joints. Treat baseboards, moldings and floors. Allow articles to thoroughly dry before use. Repeat as necessary.

To control clothes moths and carpet beetles on wool and other fabric: Remove infested articles from storage, brush thoroughly and air for several hours in sunlight if possible. Spray liberally into empty chests, closets, bureaus and other storage areas directing spray into cracks, joints and crevices. After airing, spray articles lightly, keeping nozzle at least 3 feet away from fabric to avoid staining.

To kill lice and louse eggs: Spray only garments, bedding, mattresses and furniture that cannot be laundered or dry cleaned. Test spray on an inconspicuous area for possible staining or discoloration. Inspect after drying and proceed if no color change is observed. Spray at a distance of 8-10 inches. Spray at a rate of 3 seconds per sq.ft. Allow spray to dry thoroughly before use.

AS A SPACE SPRAY:

To kill flies, houseflies, mosquitoes, cluster flies, gnats, fruit flies, small flying moths, wasps, hornets, bees, black flies, skipper flies, and blow flies: Close all doors and windows. Direct spray upward into the center of the room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room, moving toward the door as you spray. Direct spray to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract insects. Keep nozzle in constant motion. Leave room and keep closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and dispose of fallen insects. Repeat as necessary.

To kill fleas in buildings: Hold can 3 feet above the floor and direct spray toward floor and lower walls at a rate of 10 seconds per 100 sq.ft. Make sure all floor, and furniture surfaces are contacted. Leave the room and keep closed for 15 minutes. Thoroughly ventilate room before re-entry. Repeat after 7 days or as necessary.

ANIMAL TREATMENT

To kill fleas, ticks and lice on dogs: Start at the head. Stroke against the lay of the fur, spraying the parted fur in short bursts, insuring penetration of the coat. Dampen the fur all the way to the tail. Repeat applications weekly if necessary to control infestations. NOTE: Not recommended for use on puppies less than four weeks old.

To control blood sucking lice on dogs: Apply to the infested area of the animal using a stiff brush to get the spray to the base of the fur. Repeat every 3 weeks if necessary.

ANIMAL QUARTERS

To kill houseflies, mosquitoes, gnats, wasps, hornets, bees, and small flying moths: Close windows and doors and spray at a rate of 2 seconds per 1,000 cu.ft. For best results, keep area closed for 10 minutes after spraying. Remove animals from treatment area prior to treatment. Do not remain in treated area and ventilate after treatment is completed.

To kill fleas and ticks (adults and larvae): Remove and thoroughly clean or destroy pet bedding. Spray pet's sleeping quarters, bed, and entire floor and floor covering. Spray cracks and crevices around baseboards and window and door frames. Treat upholstered furniture and mattresses. Test for possible discoloration by spraying on an inconspicuous portion of furniture and other fabric.

OUTDOORS

Hold can at arms length and aim away from face and body. Hold can on a slightly downward angle. For best results, spray only when there is little or no wind. Spray with the wind at your back. Allow a few minutes for the product to work.

To kill ants, cockroaches, Asian cockroaches, crickets, mole crickets, centipedes and silverfish: Spray infested surfaces of patios or picnic areas, hitting as many insects as possible with the spray. Spray the legs of tables and chairs to control ants. Spray ant hills for best control.

To kill flies, mosquitoes, gnats, small flying moths, wasps, hornets and yellow jackets: Allow fog to drift over area. Direct spray toward bushes or grass from at least 4 to 6 feet away. Give special attention to breeding areas such as garbage cans and compost piles.

To control mud daubers and wasp nests: Use in late evening or early morning when insects are at rest. Spray mist directly on insects and their nests from approximately 2 feet away. Contact as many insects with the spray as possible as they fly away. Saturate nest openings. Repeat as necessary.

FOR USE ON PLANTS: For use on plants or as a multi-purpose spray in small gardens or for spot treatments of insect infestations to prevent spreading in larger gardens.

To kill aphids, armyworms, ants, clover mites, Japanese beetles, lace bugs, leafminers, red mites, spiders, spider mites, exposed thrips and whiteflies on African violets, asters, azaleas, begonias, camellias, carnations, chrysanthemums, dahlias, delphiniums, dogwoods, english ivy, euonymus, fuschia, geraniums, crassula, grape vine, Kentia palm, laurel, marigolds, rhododendrons, roses, rubber plants, snapdragons, stocks, wandering jews and zinnias: Spray from at least 18 inches away from plants. Use short bursts and a sweeping motion. Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Do not spray on plants when temperature is above 90°F. Do not spray on young plants or new growth.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Do not freeze. Store in a cool, dry area, inaccessible to children and away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Avoid contamination of feed or foodstuffs. Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquaria before spraying. Do not allow children or pets on treated area until spray has dried.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed: Call physician or Poison Control Center immediately.

If in eyes: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

If on skin: Wash with plenty of soap and warm water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

If inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.
