d. Under **STORAGE & DISPOSAL** change "...heat or open flame." to read "...heat, sparks, open flame or pilot light.". Also change "Replace cap and discard container in trash." to "Replace cap, wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.".

e. Replace **PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS** section with "Harmful if absorbed through skin or inhaled. Avoid contact with skin or clothing, and avoid breathing dust or spray mist. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

f. Under **STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT If inhaled:** change "Apply artificial respiration if indicated." to read "If not breathing give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth. Get medical attention.".

IMPORTANT: TO AVOID DAMAGE OR POOR RESULTS, CAREFULLY READ AND FOLLOW ALL DIRECTIONS AND PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. **FOR USE IN AND AROUND THE HOME ONLY.**

IMPORTANT: To avoid flammability hazard, use only one can per room. Do not use in small, enclosed spaces (such as in cabinets or under counters or tables). Shut off electrical equipment. Place at least 6 feet from pilot lights and appliances that cycle on and off, such as refrigerators or freezers.

One [5] oz. unit treats up to [5,000] cu.ft. of unobstructed area (a [25'] x [25'] room with an [8'] ceiling). For Fleas and Ticks, use one [5] oz. unit for every [1,250] cu.ft. of unobstructed room space ([13'] x [12'] x [8']). Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of the mist is not assured. Do not remain in the area during treatment. Ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

This product kills ants, carpet beetles, centipedes, cockroaches, confused flour beetles, crickets, earwigs, firebrats, fleas, flies, fruit flies, gnats, grasshoppers, hornets, houseflies, moths, palmetto bugs, pillbugs, rice weevils, saw-toothed grain beetles, scorpions, silverfish, small flying moths, sowbugs, spiders, ticks, wasps, waterbugs and yellow jackets

PREPARATION: In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly washed before use. Cover exposed food, dishes and food handling equipment. Exposed food should be covered or removed. Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquaria before spraying. Open cabinets and doors to areas to be treated. Shut off electrical appliances, fans and air conditioners. Close outside and exterior doors and windows. Cover waxed wood floors and waxed furniture in the area immediate surrounding the fogger (newspaper may be used). Do not place activated fogger in a cabinet or under a counter or table.

TO START FOGGING: Shake well before using. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press the valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place the fogger on a level stand or table in the center of the room with the valve locked open. Placing several layers of newspaper or pad under the fogger. NOTE: Do not place fogger on a water-stainable surface. LEAVE THE ROOM AT ONCE and keep closed for 2 hours before airing out. After 2 hours, open all doors and windows and allow to ventilate for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in 2 weeks or when necessary.

To control ticks and fleas: Old pet bedding should be removed and replaced with clean fresh bedding after treatment. Pets should be treated with a registered flea and tick control product in conjunction with this treatment.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool, dry area, inaccessible to children and away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
