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PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

DIRECTIONS FOR USE—SANITIZING OF NONPOROUS NON-FOOD CONTACT SURFACES. Prepare a sanitizing solution by thoroughly mixing 21/4 fl. oz. of this product with 5 gallons of water to provide approximately 200 ppm available chlorine by weight. Clean equipment surfaces in the normal manner. Prior to use, rinse all surfaces thoroughly with the sanitizing solution, maintaining contact with the sanitizer for at least 2 minutes. Do not rinse equipment with water after treatment and do not soak equipment overnight.
