LAWNS, RECREATIONAL AND ORNAMENTAL TURF AREAS:

For control of turfgrass pests, apply granules uniformly to the turf grass. For optimum control, follow specific directions for proper watering or irrigation after application. Keep children and pets off treated area until grass is dry.
