The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the referenced product in connection with the MGK-264, Piperonyl butoxide, and Pyrethrins REDs and has concluded that your submission is acceptable

NOTE This product is **not** being reregistered under sections 3(c)5 and 4(g) of FIFRA at this time

Please be reminded that 40 CFR Part 156 140(a)(4) requires that a batch code, lot number, or other code identifying the batch of the pesticide distributed and sold be placed on <u>non-refillable</u> containers. Entry Restrictions

For contact or surface spray do not enter or allow others to enter until sprays have dried For space spray do not allow adults children or pets to enter the treated area for at least 15 minutes until vapors mists and aerosols have dispersed and the treated area has been thoroughly ventilated

Application Restrictions

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons either directly or through drift Only protected handlers may be in the area during application

Do not enter or allow other to enter until vapors mists and/or aerosols have dispersed and the area has been thoroughly ventilated

SPACE SPRAY Close room or area to be treated. Shut off air conditioner and ventilator system. Seal all open vents Apply undiluted as a fine mist of aerosol size particles through manual electric or other powered applicators. Avoid staining by holding the spray nozzle at least 5 feet from objects. Direct the mist toward the ceiling and upper corners of the area to be treated. Fill the area with mist at a rate of 1.0 fl. oz per 1.000 cubic feet of space. Leave area closed for 30 minutes. Sweep up and destroy dead insects.

In boxcars ship cargo holds barges and trucks cover any loose or unpackaged finished foods with paper or plastic tarps. Apply space spray at a rate of 1 0 fl. ounce per 1 000 cubic feet of space. Close all doors and openings before applying spray and leave closed for 30 minutes after total dosage has been applied. Sweep up and destroy dead insects.

CONTACT CRACK & CREVICE SPRAY To kill all listed crawling insects adjust spray to produce large wetting type spray particles. Spray insects directly whenever possible. Direct spray to contact insects in cracks and crevices in floors shelves drawers base boards around pipes beams behind cabinets around heavy machinery and other harborages. Spray these infested areas at a rate of 56.4 ounces per 1000 square feet. In homes and restaurants, allow shelves and drawers to dry then cover with shelf paper.

Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water food or feed by storage or disposal

Pesticide Storage Store in a cool dry place away from heat or open flame in an area that is inaccessible to children and animals
