Directions for Use:

Using the conventional methods of application deposit 0.1% to 1.0% active ingredient on the weight of the material being treated. (Example: In order to deposit 0.1% active ingredient on the weight of the fabric, add 0.23 lbs. of Requat per 100 lbs. of fabric.) Predilute the predetermined amount of 1977 in water and mix thoroughly. Disperse that amount in the treating bath and thoroughly mix the solution. Run bath for 15 to 30 minutes. Dry the treated material in the usual manner.
