



GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

Bacteriostatic, Fungistatic, Deodorizer; inhibit the growth of odor causing bacteria; resist perspiration odors; odor resistant; resist the development of bacterial and fungal odors; controls odors washing after washing; chemically treated to control odors; to prevent deterioration and discoloration caused by fungus; resist the growth of mold and mildew; for lasting freshness; durable; non-leachable antimicrobial treatment; will prolong the life of the treated products; wash resistant; lasts through repeated washings, cleanings and shampoos; treatment is not destroyed by repeated washings.

Directions for Use:

Using the conventional methods of application deposit 0.1% to 1.0% active ingredient on the weight of the material being treated. (Example: In order to deposit 0.1% active ingredient on the weight of the fabric, add 0.16 lbs of Requat per 100 lbs of fabric.) Pre dilute the predetermined amount of 1977 in water and mix thoroughly. Disperse that amount in the treating bath and thoroughly mix the solution. Soak bath for 15 to 30 minutes. Dry the treated material in the usual manner.
