It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

CHEMSTAT 710 is used to control fungal degradation of water-based emulsifiable cutting fluids and during cleaning operations. It should be added at a rate that will provide 150 to 200 ppm of CHEMSTAT 710 (weight/weight) with water. CHEMSTAT 710 can be added to the concentrate before dilution to prevent growth on the inside walls of the fluid storage tanks, higher concentrations are needed. For this application it is recommended that CHEMSTAT 710 be diluted fluid as it is prepared to a concentration of 1000 to 1250 parts per million.
