**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

CHEMSTAT 715 is used for the control of fungal degradation of water-based emulsifiable cutting fluids and during cutting operations. It should be added to the cutting fluid at a rate that will provide 150 to 300 parts per million of CHEMSTAT 715 (weight/weight) with water. Chemstat 715 can be added to the concentrate before dilution or to the concentrate before dilution. Growth on the inside walls of the fluid storage tanks, higher concentrations are needed. For this use, it is recommended that CHEMSTAT 715 be diluted to a concentration of 1000 to 1250 parts per million.
