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BAITING

1. Select an area where mouse droppings have been seen or where mouse activity has been observed. Generally, good baiting locations are found along walls or other vertical structures, near gnawed openings or burrows. 2. Remove **MOUSEBUSTER** and the two-sided tape from the box. 3. Peel off the white side of the two-sided tape. Apply tape to the bottom of the bait station where indicated. 4. Peel off the green side of the two-sided tape. Now, making sure that the back of the **MOUSEBUSTER** is toward the wall (marked "THIS SIDE TOWARDS WALL") place **MOUSEBUSTER** along the wall. Press firmly. 5. Secure one **MOUSEBUSTER** every 8-12 feet along the walls in areas where mouse activity has been observed. 6. Dead mice may appear 4-5 days after consumption of bait begins. Monitor the contents of **MOUSEBUSTER** units and replace those found to be empty until all signs of mouse activity have ceased. Dispose of dead mice and empty **MOUSEBUSTER** properly (SEE "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL"). 7. To discourage reinfestation, eliminate sources of food, water, and harborage for mice as much as possible. 8. To remove **MOUSEBUSTER** from secured positions, work a dull putty knife or similar object through the foam portion of the two-sided tape to free station. Using your thumb, roll any pieces of tape that remain on the floor and remove them.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN OR VETERINARIAN: This product may reduce the clotting ability of the blood and cause hemorrhaging. If bleeding occurs, intramuscular and oral administration of Vitamin K1 is indicated at 2 to 5mg (not mg/kg). For severe cases, Vitamin K1 is indicated at 2 to 5mg/kg. Repeat doses may be necessary for two weeks or longer (based upon monitoring of prothrombin times). In severe cases, blood transfusions may be necessary.
