Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

Hold container upright, nozzle away from you and press actuator button spraying as directed.

To Treat Animals: To protect cattle from attacks of stable flies, horse flies, deer flies, house flies, horn flies, mosquitos and gnats, spray about 3 seconds on each side being careful to spray back, withers and forelegs thoroughly. To protect from face flies, spray the face and head, but do not spray into the eyes. Repeat treatment as necessary when flies are troublesome

In Animal Quarters & Milk Rooms: For rapid control of Houseflies, Mosquitos, Gnats, Wasps and Flying Moths close windows and doors and spray at the rate of one second per 1000 cubic feet of space. For best results keep area closed for 10 minutes after spraying. Do not remain in treated area and ventilate after treatment is completed.


