To Treat Animals: To protect cattle **(Construction**) from attacks of stable flies, horse flies, deer flies, house flies, horn flies, mosquitos and gnats, spray about three (3) seconds on each side being careful to spray back, withers and forelegs thoroughly. To protect from face flies, spray the face and head, but do not spray into the eyes. Repeat treatment as necessary when flies are troublesome.

In Animal Quarters & Milk Rooms: For rapid control of house flies, mosquitos, gnats, wasps and flying moths close windows and doors and spray at the rate of one second per 1000 cubic feet of space. For best results keep area closed for 10 minutes after spraying. Do not remain in treated area and ventilate after treatment is completed.

"Flying Insects": Flies, mosquitos, wasps and flying moths. Close doors and windows. Direct mist upwards in sweeping motion to all parts of the room especially windows and other light sources. Apply 6-10 second burst per 30 m of space. Whenever possible, keep doors and windows closed for 15 minutes after each treatment. Also direct mist into areas where insects are present. Keep spray at least 1 m from interior wall, fabrics and furniture.

"Crawling Insects": Cockroaches, spiders, crickets, ants, carpetbeetles, centipedes and silverfish. Spray hiding places such as base boards, moist areas, openings around sinks, drains and pipes, behind cabinets and storage areas. Spray ant trails, around door sills, window frames, or in ant nests. Insects must be hit to be killed.

"Bed Bugs": Spray mattress, particularly around seams and tufts. Take beds apart, spray all joints. Repeat as required.

"Fleas": Spray sleeping quarters of pets.
