For best results keep area closed for 10 minutes after spraying. Do not remain in treated area and ventilate after treatment is completed

CRAWLING INSECTS: COCKROACHES, SPIDERS, CRICKETS, ANTS, CARPET BEETLES, CENTIPEDES & SILVERFISH

Spray hiding spaces such as baseboards, moist areas, openings around sinks, drains and pipes, between cabinets and storage areas. Spray ant trails, around door sills, window frames, or in ant nests. Insects roust be hit -/ be killed


