**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS  
HAZARDS TO HUMAN AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

**CAUTION**

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapours or spray mist. Avoid contact with eyes and skin. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists.

Foods or food processing equipment should be removed or covered during treatment. Do not apply while food processing is underway. All food processing surfaces should be thoroughly cleaned before using.

Do not apply over uncovered milk or food products. Any exposed utensils or food handling surfaces should be thoroughly cleaned before use. Do not use in areas where fish or reptiles may be exposed to spray. Facilities and equipment in federally inspected meat and poultry plants must be washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse after spraying. Vacate premises after treatment. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed before reoccupying area. Remove pets, birds and cover aquariums before spraying.

**CHEMICAL OR PHYSICAL HAZARDS**

**Flammable** - Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**Storage:** Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.  
**Disposal:** "Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal."  
"Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or on an approved waste disposal facility."  
"Wrap container and put in trash collection."

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.  
Hold container upright, nozzle away from you and press actuator button spraying as directed.

**To Treat Animals:** To protect cattle from attacks of stable flies, horse flies, deer flies, house flies, hornflies, mosquitos and gnats, spray about 3 seconds on each side being careful to spray back, withers and forelegs thoroughly. To protect from face flies, spray the face and head, but do not spray into the eyes. Repeat treatment if necessary when flies are troublesome.

**In Animal Quarters & Milk Rooms:** For rapid control of house flies, mosquitos, gnats, wasps and flying moths close windows and doors and spray at the rate of one second per 1000 cubic feet of space. For best results keep area closed for 10 minutes after spraying. Do not remain in treated area and ventilate after treatment is completed.

**CRAWLING INSECTS: COCKROACHES, SPIDERS, CRICKETS, ANTS, CARPET BEETLES, CENTIPEDES & SILVERFLIES.**

Spray hiding spaces such as baseboards, moist areas, openings around sinks, drains and pipes, between cabinets and storage areas. Spray ant trails, around door sills, window frames, or in ant nests. Insects must be hit to be killed.
