To Kill Carpet Beetles: Directly spray as many insects as possible. Spray both interior and exterior of upholstered furniture. Both top and bottom of rugs and carpets should be sprayed thoroughly. Also treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture and wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.

Repeat as necessary. Do not spray animals. Put fresh bedding in pets quarters after spray has dried. Also treat dogs and cats with a registered flea and tick control product before allowing them to enter treated area.

/OUTDOORS/

To Reduce Annoyance of Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Gnats and Small Flying Moths: Spray area infested with these flying insects. Hold container 18-24 inches from shrubs, bushes and grassy areas. Spray these areas with a slow sweeping motion at the rate of 1 to 3 seconds per cubic yard of space while moving away from the treated areas. To reduce annoyance from these pests treat open porches and patios in a similar manner. Spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the treated area. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Ornamental Plant Pests Listed Below:

General: When sprayed directly on insects, this spray will kill the insects listed. Caution should be taken when spraying new tender growth on young plants.

WHEN SPRAYING, HOLD CAN 18-24 INCHES FROM PLANT.

For best results, spray in the evening or on a cloudy day when air is still. Mist the plants lightly. Use a slow sweeping motion. Avoid wetting foliage with spray.
