#### Indoors

Do not use in commercial food processing, storage, preparation or serving areas. In the home, cover or remove all food processing surfaces and utensils during treatment or thoroughly wash before use. Cover or remove exposed food. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried.

To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths, Gnats and Wasps: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying then thoroughly ventilate room before re-entry. Sweep up and discard fallen insects.

**To Kill Cockroaches, Ants and Crickets:** Contact a many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harbouring these pests. Pay special attention to cracks; hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators; food storage areas; and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ants, treat trails, doors, around window frames and other areas of entry. Repeat weekly or as reinfestation warrants.

**To Kill Carpet Beetles:** Directly spray as many insects as possible. Thoroughly spray both interior and exterior of upholstered furniture; and both top and bottom of rugs and carpets. Also treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture and wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Repeat monthly or as reinfestation warrants.

o Kill Exposed Forms of Confused Flour Beetles, Sawtoothed Grain Beetles and Rice Weevils: Remove and destroy infested package goods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects present. After shelves have dried, place clean paper on the shelves and return packages. Repeat monthly or as reinfestation warrants.

**To Kill Sowbugs, Earwigs, Centipedes, Firebrats and Spiders:** Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harbouring these pests. Pay special attention to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces under sinks, and behind stoves and refrigerators.

**To Kill Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks:** Remove and discard or wash old pet bedding. Spray pets' sleeping quarters and around baseboards, windows, door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat weekly or as reinfestation warrants. **Do not spray animals.** Put fresh bedding in pet quarters after spray has dried. Simultaneously treat dogs and cats with a product registered for flea and tick control on pets before allowing pets to enter treated areas.

**To Kill Pests on House Plants:** Kills Ants, Aphids, Young Caterpillars, Leafhoppers, Spiders, Whiteflies, Mealybugs, Spidermites, Lacebugs and Japanese Beetles on house plants such as Ivy, African Violets, Impatiens, Geraniums and Begonias. Hold container 18-24 inches from plants being sprayed. Cover upper and lower surfaces of leaves. Avoid wetting foliage with spray. Use short bursts of one second for spot application on new growth. Use with caution on young plants and new growth.

#### **Outdoors**

To Reduce Annoyances of Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Gnats and Flying Moths: Spray areas infested with these flying insects. Hold container 18-24 inches from shrubs, bushes and grassy areas. Spray these areas with a slow sweeping motion at the rate of 1 to 3 seconds per cubic yard of space while moving away from the treated areas. To reduce annoyance from these pests, treat open porches and patios in a similar manner. Spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the treated areas. Repeat every other week or as reinfestation warrants.

Kill Ornamental Plant Pests Listed Below: General: When sprayed directly on insects this spray will kill the insects listed. Use caution when spraying new tender growth or young plants. When spraying, hold can 18-24 inches from plant. For best results, spray in the evening or on a cloudy day when air is still. Lightly mist the plants using a slow sweeping motion. Avoid wetting foliage with spray. Spray rows at the rate of 1 foot per second. For heavy growth, spray both sides of row. Repeat every other week or as reinfestation warrants. Do not spray when temperatures exceed 90°F.
