

Precautionary Statements

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapours or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Call a physician immediately.

Do not apply directly to food. In commercial food handling facilities, cover or remove any food and food processing equipment during application. Do not apply while food processing is under way. After space spraying in food processing plants, wash with potable water all equipment, benches, shelving, etc., where exposed food will be handled. In the home, all food processing and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed after use.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Physical Hazards

Flammable. Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

For Control of Wasps and Hornets: It is preferable to apply this product after dark when all the insects have returned to the nest. Aim valve opening at the nest and depress button, continuing to spray until the nest is soaked with the spray. Repeat as necessary.
