

Precautionary Statements

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION

Non-Mosquito Adulticide

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: "Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal."  
"Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility." "Wrap container and put in trash collection."

For Control of Wasps and Hornets: It is preferable to apply this product after dark when all the insects have returned to the nest. Aim valve opening at the nest and depress button, continuing to spray until the nest is soaked with the spray. Repeat as necessary.
