PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazardous to the Environment and Potentially Acutely

CAUTION

May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing spray mist and provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. In case of contact immediately flush skin and eyes with plenty of water. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before smoking. If irritation occurs, get prompt medical aid.

Do not use in commercial food processing preparation, food storage or serving area. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed feet should be covered or removed.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried.

Physical or Chemical Hazards

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130 F may cause bursting.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with a finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if needed.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Remove contaminated clothing. Wash skin with soap and warm water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

General: Use this residual spray as a spot or crack and crevice treatment to control cockroaches, water bugs, silverfish, ticks, fleas, and other insects listed below. Apply this product only as a crack and crevice treatment to localized areas where pests are found or may occur. Spray surfaces until wet. Repeat as needed.

FOR FLOO TREATMENT:

To Kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Spiders, Sowbugs, Earwigs and Carpet Beetles: Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in wall; along baseboards and door and window frames; behind and beneath sinks, stove, refrigerators, and cabinets; and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants, apply to ant trails, also around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters; nearby cracks and crevices; along and behind baseboards; window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Do not Spray Pets With This Product. Pets should be treated with a registered product for flea and tick control in conjunction with this treatment.

To Kill House Flies, Horse Flies, Eye Flies, Deer Flies, Stable Flies, Cluster Flies, Horn Flies and Mosquitoes.

Use only out-of-doors as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of window and door frames as well as other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas (such as under eaves) of porches, patios and garages where these insects may congregate. Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Repeat treatment when necessary.

FOR CRACK AND CREVICE:

To Kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders, Brown Dog Ticks, Fleas, Earwigs and Carpet Beetles: Apply spray in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices. Equipment capable of delivering a pinpoint stream should be used in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floor, openings leading to walls and hollow spaces in walls, equipment joints and lines where the insects are likely to hide.
