The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

1. For all the above subject products, revise the ingredient statement so that the words **ACTIVE INGREDIENTS** and **INERT INGREDIENTS** are aligned in the same margin printed in the type of the same size and given equal prominence.
2. For EPA Reg. No. 46813-39, make the following changes:
 - a. In paragraph beginning with "Do not use in food areas....", revise the first sentence as follows:

Do not use in food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed.
 - b. Kennels should follow Homes, i.e. "For Use in Homes, Kennels, and Non-Food Areas of...etc."

- c. Add the following statement to the Directions for Use:

Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazards.

- d. Under the Directions for Use, add the statement: "For Spot/Crack and Crevice Treatment Only. Do not use as a space spray."

- e. Add the following precautionary statement: "Do not apply to classrooms when in use."

3. For both EPA Reg. No. 46813-40 and 46813-41, make the following changes:

- a. Add the following precautionary statement: "Do not apply to sick, old or debilitated animals."

- b. Add the heading **Physical and Chemical Hazards** above the statements beginning with "Contents under pressure....."

- c. Make the following additions to the **Statement of Practical Treatment**:

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center.

IF ON SKIN: Removed contaminated clothing and wash before re-use. Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF INHALED: Remove victims to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration to victim if indicated.

- d. Under Directions for Use, add the following statement after the sentence "The spray should wet the ticks thoroughly.":

"Do not, however, oversaturate the fur or skin of the animal."

Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
CAUTION**

May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing spray mist and provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. In case of contact immediately flush skin and eyes with plenty of water. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before smoking. If poisoning occurs, get prompt medical aid.

Do not use in food areas of food handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in dining areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held. Non-food areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers) entries and vestibules, floors, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, janitor's garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during the treatment, or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed. "Not for use in USDA Meat and Poultry Plants."

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Keeps under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

Swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with a finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person.

In Eyes: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if needed.

On Skin or Clothing: Remove contaminated clothing. Wash skin with soap and warm water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

GENERAL

Use this residual spray as a spot or crack and crevice treatment to control cockroaches, waterbugs, silverfish, ticks, fleas and other insects listed below. Apply this product only as a coarse spray or crack and crevice treatment to localized areas where pests are found or may occur. Spray surfaces until wet. Repeat as needed.

FOR SPOT TREATMENT

• Kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Spiders, Sowbugs, Earwigs, and Carpet Beetles: Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in wall, along baseboards and door and window frames; behind and beneath sinks, toves, refrigerators and cabinets; and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants, apply to ant trails, also around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance. Repeat as necessary.

• Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters; nearby cracks and crevices; along and behind baseboards; window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Do not spray Pets With This Product. Pets should be treated with registered product for flea and tick control in conjunction with this treatment.

• Kill House Flies, Horse Flies, Face Flies, Deer Flies, Stable Flies, Cluster Flies, Horn Flies and Mosquitoes. Use only out-of-doors as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of window and door frames as well as other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas (such as under eaves) or porches, patios and garages where these insects may congregate. Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Repeat treatment when necessary.

FOR CRACK AND CREVICE:

• Kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders, Brown Dog Ticks, Fleas, Earwigs and Carpet Beetles: Apply spray in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices. Equipment capable of delivering a pin stream should be used in joints between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases where the above listed insects hide.

Precautions should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.
