The review of the 8 month response to the DCI issued for products containing DEET has been completed. As a result of the review, the current label accepted on February 19, 2004 must be revised as follows:

1) Change the Precautionary Statements to read as follows:

"Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes. Use of this product may cause skin reactions in rare cases. Wash treated clothing before wearing it again. Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet."

- 2) In the First Aid section of the label after the statement, "Have the product container xxx for treatment." add the add the statement, "For additional information in case of emergency call toll free (Telephone Number).". Insert the proper telephone number.
- 3) In the directions add the statement, "Do not use under clothing.".
- 4) Correct the spelling of the second active ingredient.

These label changes must be made at the next printing of labels.

This product is not being re-registered at this time. Product specific efficacy data will be required. Once the efficacy guidelines are in place, you will be notified of the efficacy requirements.

Also, to be eligible for re-registration, the product must be packaged in containers utilizing a concave trigger to help aim the product or other comparable mechanism that will ensure that the product will not be inadvertently sprayed in the eyes.

The CSFs dated September 27, 2002 for the basic and alternate formulations are acceptable and have been made a part of the file for this product.
