The proposed amendment to the registration of the product cited above removing the active ingredient, R-11 and increasing the amount of one of the other active ingredients is acceptable subject to the comments listed below.

- 1) Submit a complete description of the formulation process. Describe equipment used, mixing time, temperature etc.
- 2) The pH is listed as 6.9 in the chemistry data however on the Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) it is listed as NA. Explain the discrepancy.
- 3) Based on the CSF dated March 15, 1990 the product will not meet the label claim for the active ingredients. The percentages claimed on the label must be the same as the certified lower limits listed on the CSF. Revise the label or submit a new CSF so the information agrees.

As you spray, fluff the hair so the spray will penetrate to the skin. Make sure spray wets ticks thoroughly. Do not spray into the eyes, face or on scrotum. Repeat as needed.

Do not spray on nursing puppies or kittens.
