HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Non-food areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries, and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until they are dry.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labelling. ~~Not for use in USDA meat and Poultry Plants.~~

GENERAL:

Use this product as a spot or crack and crevice treatment to control cockroaches, waterbugs, silverfish, ticks, fleas, and other insects listed below. Apply this product as a coarse spray to localized areas where pests are found or may occur. Spray surfaces until wet. Repeat as needed.

SPOT TREATMENT:

TO KILL ANTS, ROACHES, CRICKETS, SILVERFISH, SOWBUGS, SPIDERS, AND EARWIGS:

Spray into cracks, crevices, around baseboards and other places where these insects hide. Apply behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, and in and around waste containers. Contact directly as many insects as possible. For ants, spray trails and places where ants enter premises. Repeat as necessary for control.

TO KILL BROWN DOG TICKS AND FLEAS:

Remove and destroy old bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, windows and door frames, wall cracks, and localized areas of floors. Repeat as necessary. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters after spray has dried. Do not spray animals. To control the source of your infestation treat your pets with a product registered for application to animals.

TO KILL CARPET BEETLES:

Spray along baseboards, edges of carpeting under carpets and rugs, under furniture, in closets, on shelving, and in other places of harbourage. Repeat as necessary.

FOR CRACK AND CREVICE:

To kill ants, roaches, silverfish, crickets, sowbugs, spiders, earwigs, brown dog ticks, fleas, carpet beetles and dermestids: Use a spot treatment in and around areas where the above pests have been seen or are suspected of hiding or entering.

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FOR CRACK AND CREVICE: (Cont/d)

Apply only enough spray to thoroughly cover the surfaces treated using special care to avoid unnecessary runoff. Do not introduce the spray into the air or allow the spray to contact food or food-contacting surfaces. Areas treated may include dark corners, or rooms and closets, along and behind baseboards, beneath and behind stoves and refrigeration units, floor drains and around plumbing and other utility installations.

FOR CRACK AND CREVICE INJECTION SYSTEM:

Equipment capable of delivering a pin stream should be used in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases where the above listed insects hide.

Do not apply this product in conduits, motor housings, junction and switch boxes, or other electrical equipment because of possible shock hazard.

OUTDOOR USE:

TO KILL ANTS, CRICKETS, FLEAS, CHIGGERS, AND BROWN DOG TICKS:

Spray infested areas thoroughly including outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames, foundations, patios, or other places where insect may enter. For ants, spray hills and runways. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray vegetation.

TO KILL FLIES, MOSQUITOES, WASPS, AND FLYING MOTHS:

For outdoor use only as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of screens, doors, windows or wherever these pests may enter a room. Also treat surfaces around light fixtures on porches, in garages, and other places where insects alight or congregate.
