WARNING

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

- IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.
- IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and warm water.
- IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labelling.

To Kill Fleas, Lice and Ticks:

Dilute 2 fluid ounces (4 Tablespoons), with one gallon of water. Dip animal into solution, making sure hair is thoroughly wet to the skin. The area around the ears should be opened thoroughly. Avoid contact of material with eyes and mouth of animal. Repeat application every two weeks or as necessary.

This concentrate gives long lasting residual control and repellency of fleas and ticks on dogs and cats.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
