c. Add "Physical or Chemical Hazards" before "Contents under pressure." and revise as follows:

Physical or Chemical Hazards

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

d. Revise the Statement of Practical Treatment as follows:

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Remove contaminated clothing and wash before re-use. Wash skin with soap and warm water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

e. Under "Disposal," remove the quotation marks from "Do not puncture or incinerate."

f. Under Directions for Use add:

i. Using protective mitts or gloves, rub foam thoroughly into the pet's coat... etc.

ii. Do not spray in face, eyes, or on genitalia. Repeat weekly if necessary.

g. Update the label so it reflects your correct address.

h. Correct the typo in "See Back Panel for Additional Precautionary Statements."

3. Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labelling.

This product will kill fleas up to 14 days on dogs and cats and will kill ticks for 4 days on dogs and 9 days on cats.

Shake can well before using. Hold can about 1 inch above pet's back and spray the foam from pet's head to tail. Rub the foam thoroughly into the pet's coat using a comb, brush or hand. Be sure that foam is worked thoroughly into pet's coat down to the skin. Repeat weekly if necessary.
