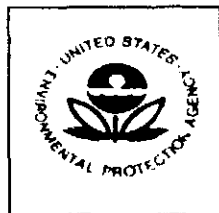

On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.

2. Make the following label changes:

- a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 46813-61".
- b. In accordance with the Resmethrin registration standard, the active ingredient must be listed as "Resmethrin" and all other names should be deleted.
- c. Delete "w/w" from the ingredient statement.

- d. The second footnote to the ingredient statement should read: "Contains petroleum distillate, xylene, or xylene range aromatic solvent."
 - e. Delete the language from the Features and Applications section: "Especially effective in killing" and replace it with "Kills". Unless you justify it, this language is false and misleading.
 - f. Delete "ants" from the Features and Applications section. Ants are not listed on the label of the product to which you are claiming similarity, and you have not included ants in the Directions for Use. If you wish to add ants to the label, you must submit a label amendment and include them in the directions for use.
 - g. Modify the Precautionary Statements to read as follows:
"Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Causes eye irritation. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove pets and cover fish aquariums before spraying."
 - h. Modify the First Aid statement to read as follows: If in eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
 - i. Add a "Storage and Disposal" statement, set apart from the directions for use, as follows:
"Storage and Disposal
Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.
Container Disposal: Securely wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
Storage: Keep in a locked storage area."
 - j. Because you are not seeking registration of this product for use in either food or non-food areas of food handling establishments, you must delete the directions relating to this use.
3. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.
 4. Submit a Confidential Statement of Formula revised so that the certified limits of the active ingredient bracket the nominal concentration (0.15%) of the active ingredient resmethrin.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

FEATURES AND APPLICATIONS

Especially effective in killing: Hornets, Wasps, Yellow Jackets, ~~Ants~~ and Bees. For outdoor use in and around industrial, commercial, medical, and residential facilities; can also be used in unfinished attics, basements, garages, barns, sheds, and warehouses, and in vehicles and other areas where foods/drinks/feeds are not exposed.

Environmental Hazards

For use in and around industrial, commercial, office, institutional and storage buildings, boats, ship cabins and hospitals. In hospitals, remove patients prior to treatment. Ventilate the area for 2 hours prior to returning the patients. Also for use in buses, automobiles, trucks, boxcars and ship cargo holds. Also for use in dog kennels and horse stables. In horse stables, not for application if horses will be used for food. Do not get spray on people, pets and vegetation. Do not use indoors as a space spray. Remove pets (including birds and fishes) and cover non-movable aquariums, etc. in area to be sprayed. ~~Do not use in food areas of food handling establishments, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Wash any contaminated foods/drinks/feed contact surfaces with soap or detergent and rinse with potable (drinking) water before use.~~

Remove protective cap. Aim spray opening away from person. Push button to spray.

INDOOR TO KILL WASPS, HORNETS, YELLOW JACKETS - Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, particularly under rafters, contacting as many insects as possible. Saturate areas in and around nest openings. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL SPIDERS - Spray directly on these pests and use repeated applications to the webbing and all cracks and crevices which harbor spiders.

OUTDOORS TO KILL WASPS, HORNETS, YELLOW JACKETS - Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Aim spray at nest openings in trees, bushes, under eaves, chimneys, cracks and crevices to saturate in and around nest openings. Contact as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL TENT CATERPILLARS - Application should be made when caterpillars are young and tents are first noticed. For best results, apply in the late afternoon or evening when caterpillars have returned to their tents. Aim spray directly at tents, and totally saturate on all sides. Repeat as necessary.
