Directions For Use:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Shake well before using. Snip off end of easy to use applicator spout at the first ridge or lower. Apply by using the handy squeeze bottle or by using a teaspoon or small (paint type) brush. Any powder visible after application should be carefully brushed into cracks and crevices, or removed. Reapply as necessary. Do not use in areas where powder will become wet.

HOUSEHOLD APPLICATIONS: Remove all lower drawers in kitchen and bath, and scatter liberally in drawer wells. Spread 1/2 teaspoon in each corner of shelf. Use in closets, garages, and around window sills and door jambs. Also use under cabinets, dressers, bookcases, behind refrigerator, ranges, washers, dryers, and dishwashers. Recommended application rate— 1 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft.

NEW CONSTRUCTION AND COMMERCIAL APPLICATIONS: Drill 1/2" holes in kick plates of cabinets and apply liberally with applicator spout. Also use in walls, soffits, and sub cabinets voids, behind long banks of appliances or lockers, into pits under dumbwaiters and under booth seats. Apply under pallets and behind boxes in storerooms. Recommended application rate— 1 lb. per 500 sq. ft.

Any powder visible after application must be brushed into cracks and crevices or removed. Apply only in areas inaccessible to children and pets. Do not use in edible product areas of food handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared, or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs.
