

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Polycide is used

in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and indoor effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial fluid ounces of Polycide per 1,000 gallons of water. Before use, remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of pools with heavy algae growth, pool add initially 41 to 75 fluid ounces of Polycide per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of Polycide per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and decorative fountains require an initial dose of 8 to 12 fluid ounces of Polycide per 1,000 gallons of water. For treatment of a freshly cleaned hot tub or decorative fountain, add initially 4 fluid ounces of Polycide per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of Polycide should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Polycide is compatible with most pool chemicals used to treat pools, spas, and decorative fountains and should be used with an alkaline pH. Polycide can be used in decorative fountains treated with chlorine chemicals and other chemicals normally required. However, do not mix Polycide with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep container closed when not in use. Containers should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded with clear water. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children and away from food.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap
