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

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the labeling.

SYSTEMCIDE #2 is used to inhibit the fungal degradation of water-based and emulsifiable cutting fluids and cooling fluids during operations. It should be added to the fluid at a rate that will provide 150 to 250 ppm of SYSTEMCIDE #2 (weight/weight) with water. SYSTEMCIDE #2 can be added to the concentrate before dilution to prevent growth on the inside walls of the dilution fluid storage tanks, higher concentrations are needed. For this application it is recommended that SYSTEMCIDE #2 be added to the diluted fluid as it is prepared to provide a concentration of 1000 to 1250 parts per million.
