### DIRECTIONS FOR USE GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Algatec is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools and hot tubs. For maximum effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools with heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using Algatec.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of Algatec per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris. In a freshly cleaned and filled pool add initially 39 to 71 fluid ounces of Algatec per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 13 to 26 fluid ounces of Algatec per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, or hot tubs having just visible algae growth require 13 to 26 fluid ounces of Algatec per 1000 gallons of water. For treatment of a spa, whirlpool, or hot tub, add initially 4 to 8 fluid ounces of Algatec per 1000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 1 to 3 fluid ounces of Algatec should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Algatec is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools. Algatec is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. Algatec can be used in pools and hot tubs with other chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally used. Do not mix Algatec with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE:** Keep container closed when not in use. Leaking or damaged containers should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded in trash. Mop up spills with water. Spills should be kept out of reach of children and stored away from food.

**DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and discard in trash.

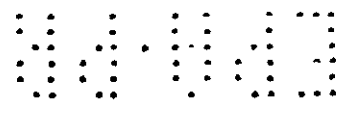
