Take the work out of winterizing your pool with Algatec. At the end of the swim season, after leaves and excess debris have stopped dropping into the pool, add the correct initial dosage for your pool size. Follow with maintenance dosages, if pool is not covered, until next swim season. When winterizing your pool with Algatec for seasonal shutdown, you can usually eliminate pH control, chlorination, and treatment tests during this non-use period.

Algatec is compatible with those chemicals (including chlorine) normally used to treat pools and spas and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. Algatec in pools and spas may reduce the amount of chlorine normally required. For maximum effectiveness, add Algatec uniformly throughout the pool water. However, do not mix Algatec with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.
