1. Under **Note to Physician**, please insert the wording "**by injection**" in the phrase "**Atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal.**"
2. Add the following precautions to "**RESTRICTIONS**": **For external insecticide use on above specified animals only. Provide thorough ventilation while dusting.**

Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

**HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**

**IF SWALLOWED** - Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**IF INHALED** - Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. Get medical attention if victim displays signs of poisoning.

**IF ON SKIN** - Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

**IF IN EYES** - Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

**TO PHYSICIAN:** Prolonged exposure will result in cholinesterase depression. Atropine sulfate is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.
