for Dipropyl Isocinchomeronate
Fly Wipe A-Way

The amendment to remove the active ingredient Dipropyl Isocinchomeronate (MGK-326) from this product referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. The confidential statement of formula for the basic formulation (dated October 11, 1994) is acceptable and supersedes all previously accepted confidential statements of formula for this product.

The labeling submitted in conjunction with this request for amended registration is acceptable, provided you make the following changes:

1. Revise the Precautionary Statement to read as follows:

"Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse."

2. Add a Statement of Practical Treatment that reads as follows:

IF SWALLOWED: Call a doctor or get medical attention. Do not induce vomiting. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Avoid alcohol. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash thoroughly with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

3. Move the following statement from the Precautionary Statements to the Directions for Use:

"NOTICE: Do not use this product on heated or wet animals as it may cause blisters."

4. Move the signal word "CAUTION" so that it appears below the subheading "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" in the Precautionary Statement, rather than above it.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed. Prior to releasing product for shipment, submit three copies of revised final printed labeling.

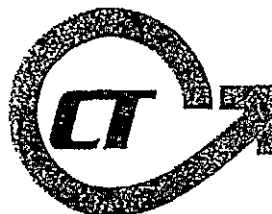
