**WARNING**

Keep the room closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room when treatment is completed.

**ANTS:** Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

Do not spray air in rooms or use on plants. Apply as a surface spray only as specified on this label.

Do not allow spray to contact food, foodstuffs or water supplies. Thoroughly wash dishes and food handling utensils if contaminated with this product. Remove pets and cover fish bowls before spraying.

This product is toxic to fish. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Do not reuse empty container. Destroy when empty and discard in a safe place.

### FOR SPOT APPLICATION ONLY

Use as a spot treatment to control cockroaches, silverfish, spiders and other pests specified herein. Use a coarse (large droplet) spray to localize where pests may occur. Spray surfaces until wet. Re-treat as needed.

**Cockroaches, Ants, Crickets, Silverfish, Spiders:** Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along baseboards and door and window sills and frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Holes driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants apply to ant trails, also around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance.

**Brown Dog Ticks:** To control these pests, thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor covering where these pests may be present. Old bedding of pets should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Do not spray pets with this product.

**Flies and mosquitoes:** Use only out-of-doors as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of window and door frames as well as other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized nesting areas (such as under eaves) or porches, patios and garages where these insects may congregate. Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Repeat treatment when effectiveness diminishes.

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
