CAUTION**

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Avoid inhalation of spray mist. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs.

When using this product as a space spray in food processing plants, foods must be removed or covered during treatment. Apply only when the facility is not in operation. Cover food contact surfaces, benches, utensils, equipment, etc., during treatment or thoroughly clean prior to use with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse.

In hospitals or other medical facilities, remove patients prior to treatment. Ventilate treated area for two hours prior to returning patients.

Do not remain in treated areas and ventilate the area after treatment is completed.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Extremely flammable. Contents under pressure. Keep away from fire, sparks, and heated surfaces. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130° F. may cause bursting.

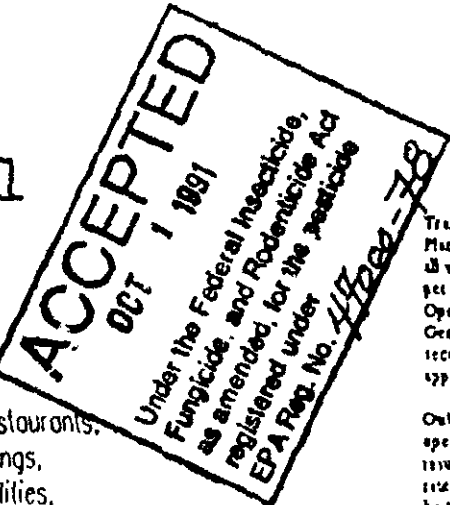
