DIRECTIONS FOR USE (Continued)

Remove protective cap. Aim spray opening away from person. Push button to spray.

INDOORS: To kill wasps, hornets, yellow jackets: Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, particularly under rafters, contacting as many insects as possible. Saturate areas in and around nest openings. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL SPIDERS: Spray directly on these pests and use repeated applications to the webbing and all cracks and crevices which harbor spiders.

OUTDOORS: To kill wasps, hornets, yellow jackets: Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Aim spray at nest openings in trees, bushes, under eaves, chimneys, cracks and crevices to saturate in and around nest openings. Contact as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL SPIDERS: Same as directed above for indoor application.

TO KILL TENT CATERPILLARS: Application should be made when caterpillars are young and tents are first noticed. For best results apply in the late afternoon or evening when caterpillars have returned to their tents. Aim spray directly at tents, and totally saturate on all sides. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Store in a cool, dry area in original container in locked area. Disposal: Replace cap, securely wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
