**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Avoid inhalation of spray mist. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs.

When using this product as a space spray in food processing plants, foods must be removed or covered during treatment. Apply only when the facility is not in operation. At home and in food processing establishments, cover or remove food prior to treatment. Cover food contact surfaces, benches, utensils, equipment, etc., during treatment or thoroughly clean prior to use with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse.

In hospitals or other medical facilities, remove patients prior to treatment. Ventilate treated area for two hours prior to returning patients.

Do not remain in treated areas and ventilate the area after treatment is completed.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Do not spray on plastic, painted or varnished surfaces or directly into electronic equipment such as radios, TVs, computers, etc.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS: Extremely Flammable. Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130° F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry, secure area.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

Remove protective cap. Aim spray opening away from person. Push button to spray.

BEEF CATTLE OPERATIONS: In barns, close all windows and doors. Apply at the rate of 1 to 2 seconds per 1000 cubic feet. Keep area closed for 15 minutes following application. If area cannot be closed, double the dosage. For animal use, thoroughly spray entire animal as it is being released to pasture. Do not spray directly towards animal's face or eyes. Repeat application daily or as necessary.

POULTRY OPERATIONS: For poultry houses, close all windows and doors. Spray at the rate of 1 to 2 seconds per 1000 cubic feet. Keep area closed for 15 minutes following application. If area cannot be closed, double the dosage.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

HOME AND FOOD PROCESSING AREA USE: For small flying moths (millers), and gnats: Close room, Point nozzle upward, direct the spray mist especially windows and other light sources. Kill insects. Fill the room with mist, then leave the room closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate when completed. Roaches, Waterbugs, Sowbugs, Centipedes: spray thoroughly into hiding places, under baseboards and storage areas. Spray daily if possible. Repeat as necessary. **ANTS:** Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

STORED PRODUCT INSECTS (accessible to): Mediterranean flour moths, Indian meal (choyudo) grain moths: Close doors and windows. Direct spray into product containers where adult moths may be present. Treatment of six to eight seconds per 1000 cubic feet. area closed for 30 minutes after each treatment. Repeat weekly or as flying moths appear. Insecticide should be fumigated or treated with an appropriate insecticide.

DAIRY FARM USE: Milking parlor and milking rooms cannot be closed, double the dosage. Direct spray in all directions. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after treatment is completed. Cover milking utensils to prevent contamination from spray and dead or falling insects.

DAIRY ANIMAL USE: From approximately 10 feet, spray entire animal as it is being released. Directly toward animal's eyes. Spot treat with insecticide where saliva accumulates from head to tail.

STANCHION BARN USE: Walk behind animal, spray backs allowing 1 second per animal. For milking parlors, each morning.

HOG OPERATIONS: In hog houses, close doors. Apply at the rate of 1 to 2 seconds per 1000 cubic feet. Keep area closed for 15 minutes following application. If area cannot be closed, double the dosage. For animal application, spray for 1 to 2 seconds per hog. Do not spray directly on animal's face or eyes. Repeat application as necessary.

HORSE BARN AND STABLES: In horse barns, close windows and doors. Spray at the rate of 1 to 2 seconds per 1000 cubic feet. Keep area closed for 15 minutes following application. If area cannot be closed, double the dosage. In mist over backs of horses and ponies from 10 feet. Do not spray directly toward horses face or eyes daily or as necessary.
