# For use in and around Non Food/Feed Areas of (but not limited to) Beef Cattle Operations, Campgrounds, Catteries, Dairy Farms (including Milk House, Milk Parlor, Loading Sheds, and Holding

(including Milk House, Milk Parlor, Loading Sheds, and Holding Lot), Food Storage Areas, Hog Operations, Homes, Horse Barns and Stables, Hospitals (non-occupied patient areas), Hotels, Kenriels, Motels, Poultry Operations, Resorts, Restaurants and other Food Handling Establishments, Schools, Supermarkets, Utikites, Vehicles, Warehouses, and other Commercial and Industrial Buildings.



LIVESTOCK USE (DO NOT USE ON SICK ANIMALS) - From approximately 2 feet away, thoroughly spray entire animal as it is being released to pasture. Do not spray directly loward animal's eyes. Spot treat withers, shoulders and back where saliva accumulates from head tossing. Apply for 2 to 4 seconds per animal. Repeat daily or as needed. To control Blood Sucking Lice, apply to the infested areas of the animal, using a still brush to get the spray to the base of the hair. Repeat every 3 weeks if required.

#### IN STANCHION BARNS

Walk behind animals and direct spray over backs allowing 1 second per animal. Apply each morning for best results.

# II TEE CATTLE, GOAT, AND SHEEP OPERATIONS.

Close all windows and doors, and spray at a rate of 1 to 2 seconds per 1000 cu. ft. If area cannot be closed, double the dosage. Leave room and keep area closed for 15 minutes following application. Ventilate area after treatment is complete. FOR ANIMAL APPLICATION (Do not use on sick animals), from approximately 2 feet away, thoroughly spray entire animal, preferably as it is being released to pasture. Do not spray directly toward animal's face or eyes. Apply for 2 to 4 seconds per animal. Repeat daily or as needed. To control *Blood Sucking Lice*, apply to the

inlested areas of the animal, using a stiff brush to get the spray to the base of the hair. Repeat every 3 weeks if required.

#### IN POULTRY OPERATIONS:

Use only in unoccupied poultry houses when birds are not present. Close all windows and doors, and spray at a rate of 1 to 2 seconds per 1000 cu. ft, moving toward the door. If area cannot be closed, clouble the dosage. Leave room and keep area closed for 15 minutes following application. Ventilate area after treatment is complete. Treat daily or as needed.

To control *Poultry Lice*, spray roosts, walls and nests or cages thoroughly. This should be followed by spraying over the birds with a fine mist.

For control of *Bedbugs and Mites* in poultry houses, spray crevices of roost poles, cracks in walls, and cracks in nests where the bedbugs and mites hide.

#### IN HOG OPERATIONS;

Close windows and doors and direct log upward in all directions at a rate of 1 to 2 seconds per 1000 cubic to t of space, moving toward the door. If area cannot be closed, double the dosage, Leave room and for best results, keep area closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Do not remain in weated area. Open and ventilate after treatment is completed.

HOG APPLICATION (DO NOT USE ON SICK ANIMALS) - From approximately 2 feet away, thoroughly spray entire animal as it is being released to pasture. Do not spray directly toward animal's face or eyes.
