ANIMAL USE--From approximately 2 foot distance, thoroughly spray entire animal as it is being released to pasture. Do not spray directly toward animal's eyes. Spot treat withers, shoulders and back where saliva accumulates from head tossing.

POULTRY OPERATIONS: Use only in empty poultry houses (when birds are not present). Close all windows and doors. Spray at the rate of 1 to 2 seconds per 1000 cubic feet. Keep area closed for 15 minutes following application. If area cannot be closed, double the dosage. Treat daily or as necessary.

HOC OPERATIONS: In hog houses, Close all windows and doors. Apply at the rate of 1 to 2 seconds per 1000 cubic feet. Keep area closed for 15 minutes following application. For animal application, direct the spray over backs and spray for 1 to 2 seconds per hog. Do not spray directly towards animal's face or eyes. Repeat application daily or as necessary.
