It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Cover exposed foods, dishes and food-handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one unit for each 6,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured. Do not remain in the area during treatment, and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

DO NOT use more than one fogger per room. DO NOT use in small, enclosed spaces such as closets, cabinets or under counters of tables. Do not use in a room 5 ft. x 5 ft. or smaller; instead, allow fog to enter from other rooms. Turn off ALL ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valves), other open flames or running electrical appliances that cycle off and on (i.e., refrigerators, thermostats, etc.). Call you gas utility or management company if you need assistance with your pilot lights.

TO OPERATE VALVE: To lock in open position for automatic discharge, press valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table in the center of the room with valve locked open, placing several layers of newspaper or pad under fogger. Leave building at once and keep building closed for two hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for one-half hour. Repeat spaying in two weeks or when necessary.

<u>To Kili Ticks and Fleas</u>: Destroy pet's old bedding and replace. Use product as above. Pets should be treated with a registered flea and tick control product prior to reentry. Repeat as necessary to bring infestation under control.
