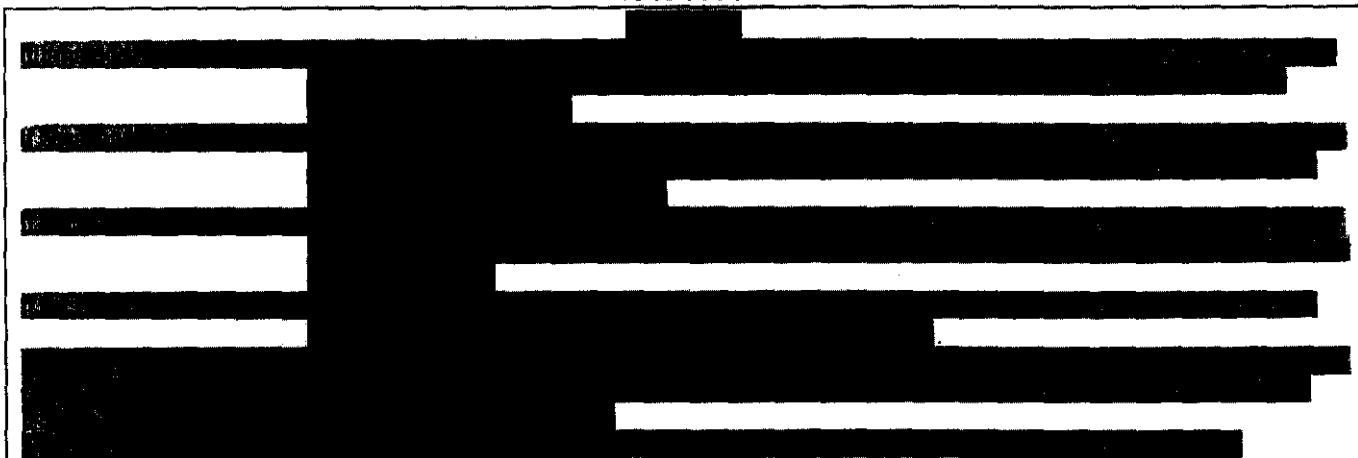

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.
