Since this product contains petroleum distillate "in any amount", the First Aid statements must include the following:

If swallowed: Immediately call a poison control center or doctor. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Add to the directions for use in hospitals the following:

In hospitals, remove patients before spraying room. Ventilate room for two hours before returning patients.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING AND AT INTERVALS DURING PROLONGED USE

This product is for use on inanimate surfaces only. For control of lice on humans use a pediculicide (lice treatment) specifically designed for that purpose.

Do not use in food areas of food handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where food may be prepared or held. Non-food areas include garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets, and storage (after canning and bottling).

In the home, cover all food handling surfaces and cover or remove all food and cooking utensils or wash thoroughly after treatment. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

FOR USE ON INANIMATE SURFACES:

Including garments, bedding, mattresses, furniture, floor and carpeting. Hold can upright with nozzle away from you. Press button and spray surface to be treated from a distance of 10 inches. First treat an inconspicuous area to test for possible staining or discoloration, inspect after drying, then proceed to spray the entire area to be treated. Treat each square foot for 3 seconds, directing the spray to moisten all infested surfaces.

In treating bedding, make sure the spray is directed into all corners of fitted sheets and blankets as well as the inside and outside of pillow cases. In treating garments and headgear, (including sports gear that may be passes from player to player) close attention should be given to seams, hems, cuffs, collars, and creases. After treatment, bedding and all garments must be either laundered in hot water or dry cleaned.

For mattresses, furniture and carpeting: direct spray to moisten all folds, tucks, seams, and crevices of infested areas. Allow the treated surface to dry completely before use.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place away from children, preferably a secure storage area.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not puncture or incinerate! **If empty:** Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If partly filled:** Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions.
