PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

May be fatal if absorbed through skin. Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Avoid breathing spray mist. Wear protective clothing and waterproof gloves. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals. Wash hands thoroughly before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Extremely flammable. Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks, and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130° F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

HOW TO USE:

Shake container well before use. Point sprayer button at the insects to be sprayed or the surfaces to be treated and press down. Spray surfaces until lightly moist, moving the container to keep from excessively wetting the surface and wasting product. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact any person or pet either directly or indirectly. Keep people and pets out of the area during application.

NOTE: Application to plants will cause damage. Rinse accidentally sprayed plants immediately. Do not use as a space spray for flying insects. Cover or remove fish bowls (tanks) before using product. Exposed food should be covered or removed during spraying and food handling surfaces should be washed with soap and water before use. Do not use in serving/dining areas of restaurants. Entry Restrictions: Do not allow people or pets to enter treated area until the spray has dried.

Applications within Food Areas of Food Handling Establishments; Includes areas for receiving, storage, packaging (canning, wrapping, bottling, boxing), preparing, edible waste storage, and enclosed processing systems (mills, dairies, edible oils, syrups).

Limited to Crack & Crevice Treatment Only. Apply a small amount of material directly into cracks and crevices such as expansion joints between different elements of construction or between equipment bases and the floor, wall voids, motor housing and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases where insects hide. Do not allow the product to be deposited on exposed surfaces or introduced into the air. Do not contaminate food, food utensils or food processing surfaces.

CONTROLS:

Ants (excluding fire, harvester and pharaoh ants): Spray directly on ants and ant trails. Follow the trail back to the source of entry into the house, usually a crack or crevice in the flooring or wall, or window or door frame. Repeat treatment when pests noted, but not more frequently than monthly.

Roaches, Spiders (including Black Widow Spiders), Crickets, Silverfish, Firebrats, Centipedes, Millipedes, Pillbugs, and Sowbugs: Spray crack and crevices treatments only. Repeat treatment when pests are seen, but not more frequently than 6 to 8 weeks.

Carpet Beetles: Spray directly on beetles or larvae when seen. Spray along baseboards and edges of rugs and carpeting. Spot spray backing of rugs and carpets and allow to dry thoroughly before replacing on floor. Also treat under furniture, in closets (baseboards and shelving), and wherever the larvae are suspected. Repeat treatment should not be necessary for 6 to 8 weeks.

Fleas and ticks: For use in kennels. Spray around animal resting areas, cracks and crevices in flooring and wall/baseboard areas, window and door frames, and other areas where pests are seen. The animal's bedding should be removed and laundered or replaced. Do not treat pets with this product. Use a product labeled for use on animals and also treat the outdoor areas used by the animals with a registered product approved for this use for complete control.

Outdoor Use: Spray only (a) outside surfaces of residential and commercial buildings and (b) around patios, driveways, sidewalks and foundations.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry well-ventilated area away from heat or open flames. Keep this product in a tightly closed area when not in use.

DISPOSAL: Do not puncture or incinerate. **If Empty:** Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If Partially Filled:** Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instruction.
