The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the above referenced product in connection with the pyrethrin, pbo, and mgk 264 RED(s), and has concluded that your submission is acceptable.

NOTE: This product is not being reregistered under sections 3(c)5 and 4(g) of FIFRA at this time.

Please be reminded that 40 CFR Part 156.140(a)(4) requires that a batch code, lot number, or other code identifying the batch of the pesticide distributed and sold be placed on non-refillable containers. The code may appear either on the label or durably marked on the container itself, and can be added by non-notification per PRN 98-10.

A copy of your label stamped "Accepted" is enclosed for the subject product. Products shipped after 12 months from the date of this amendment or the next printing of the label whichever occurs first, must bear the new revised label. Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended label constitutes acceptance of these conditions. RESTRICTIONS

Entry Restrictions:

For surface spray use – Do not enter or allow others to enter until sprays have dried.

For space spray use - Do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter the treated area for at least 15 minutes, until vapors, mists, and aerosols have dispersed, and the treated area has been thoroughly ventilated.

Application Restrictions:

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application.

Do not remain in treated area. Exit area immediately and remain outside the treated area until aerosols, vapors, and/or mists have dispersed.

Do not wet articles to point of runoff or drip. Do not use treated articles until spray has dried.

Remove or cover exposed food and drinking water before application. Remover or cover dishes, utensils, food processing equipment, and food preparation surfaces, or wash them before use.

Do not make space spray applications when facility is in operation. Prior to space spray applications, cover or remove food. Prior to space spray applications, cover food processing surfaces or clean after treatment before use. Do not apply more than 1 time per day.

How To Use: This concentrate is designed for use undiluted in mechanical sprayers that deliver aerosol size droplets (30 microns or less). It can be diluted with an odorless light petroleum oil conforming to 21CFR 172.882 or 40CFR 180.810 (Inert ingredients used pre- and post-harvest, exemptions from a tolerance). It can also be diluted with water and applied as a contact spray to kill crawling insects shown on this label.

SPACE SPRAY

<u>Undiluted in Aerosol Generators</u> – To kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths and Gnats. Close room and shut off all air-conditioning or ventilating equipment. Apply at the rate of 0.3 ounces of undiluted concentrate per 1,000 cubic feet of space. Direct output from aerosol generator upward towards upper corners of room and ceiling. Leave room closed for one half hour. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed.

<u>Diluted for Ordinary Mechanical Fogging Equipment</u> - Close room and shut off all air-conditioning or ventilating equipment. Dilute concentrate with oil at the rate of 1 part concentrate plus 15 parts of oil and mix well. Apply at the rate of 50 fluid ounces diluted spray (0.4 gallons) per 25,000

cubic feet of space. Direct fog upward towards corners of room and ceiling area. Leave room closed for one half hour. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed.

CONTACT SPRAY

Diluted for use with sprayers that give large, wetting spray particles – to kill Cockroaches and accessible stages of Granary Insects: Granary Weevils, Rice Weevils, Confused Flour Beetles, Red Flour Beetles, Meal Moth larvae and adults, Cadelles, Grain Mites and Saw-toothed Grain Beetles. Dilute concentrate with water at the rate of 1 part concentrate plus 40 parts water and mix well. Spray outside walls of grain bins, flooring, around base of milling machinery, wall and baseboards, areas behind cabinets, around pipes and other insect harborages using one gallon spray per 1,000 square feet of space. Force spray into all cracks and crevices. Repeat application as necessary. Do not apply more than 1 time per day.

Note: Infested stored food products should be removed and destroyed or fumigated using an approved product intended for this purpose.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in original container upright at room temperature in a secure area. Avoid extreme temperatures.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

CONTAINER HANDLING: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse container (or equivalent) promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or mix tank and drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Fill the container ¼ full with water or appropriate spray oil and recap. Shake for 10 seconds. Pour rinsate into application equipment or mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling if available, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.
