DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

WHERE & HOW TO USE THIS PRODUCT: This product is ready to use and should be dispensed to the end use location through an applicator tip which is affixed to a "Squeeze Bottle" or other suitable application equipment. It can be used as is for a Bait Placement or applied in various type Bait Stations and then placed in appropriate locations where insects have been seen and where they seem to congregate. It may be used in Food Storage Areas, Processing & Serving Areas or in bath rooms, Sleeping Rooms, Closets, and Food Disposal Areas in Homes, Restaurants, Hospitals, Apartments, Condominiums, Grocery Stores, Cafeterias, Warehouses, Storage Areas, and in Food Processing Plants. Do not place the Bait in areas or locations accessible to childrens or pets. Do not use on Marble or Limestone surfaces.

When used in edible product areas of food-processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed, place bait in suitable Bait Stations located behind or under fixtures. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed. Bait may be applied directly to the undersides or vertical portions of these fixtures. It will remain as applied.

HOW MUCH TO USE: Bait Station Method- This method is the best way to apply the product since the bait placements or locations may be moved, discarded, or replenished as the bait may become dirty, over-run by dead insects, or control has been achieved. By "Squeezing" the Flowable Bait through an applicator tip make a "bead line" of bait inside the bait station in the form of a circle, square or "X". Due to the unique flowable form of the bait it will remain in the shape in which it is placed and will not move or run. Apply an amount equivalent to a teaspoonful of bait per location.

WHERE TO PLACE BAIT STATIONS: Place the "prepared" bait station with bait applied therein near Ant Trails, or other areas where insects have been seen, as under and behind stoves, refrigerators, food storage bins, or trash and storage areas, along baseboards in the kitchen, and areas where they may enter indoors through doorways, window frames and screens, and through electrical or plumbing outlets.

APPLY DIRECTLY TO PREMISES WITHOUT BAIT STATIONS: If the use of Bait Stations is neither necessary or practical the Bait may be placed along Baseboards, Door entryways, or other areas such as cracks and crevices where insects may enter, hide or breed. Squeeze the Bait out through an "Applicator Tip" to form a Bait Strip making sure to conceal the placement from children and pets. The material may be directly applied to the undersides of shelving, drawers, or kitchen sinks and to vertical areas of walls, room corners and cupboards. The bait will stay where it is placed as long as the surface is porous and not highly polished. Application to the flooring areas may be made at any location as long as there is no danger of children or pet contact with the bait and it is not in traffic areas. Place Bait in cracks & crevices.

HOW OFTEN TO USE: Bait Placements should be inspected frequently to check for effectiveness. Keep Bait out for at least several weeks and repeat at regular monthly intervals until insects appear to be under control. If bait is dusty or dirty replace with fresh material. A highly significant reduction of insect populations can be expected within the first 30 days of baiting and if baiting can be maintained for up to 9 months the treatment is capable of destroying entire insect colonies which may be entering or living inside the premises.
