Subject: Amendment - Add Directions
for Sprayer Attachment
EPA Reg. No. 47123-14
Your Application Dated March 15, 1985

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA as amended, is acceptable, provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. Under item 2 on draft labeling change "according to chemical instructions on label" to "according to sprayer setting instructions on label".
 - b. Move the statements "Set sprayer at correct setting and spray thoroughly upper and lower leaf surfaces and other infested plant parts. Repeat treatment as needed." to follow statement 4 of label text.
3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.
4. Since the label with the sprayer applicator is different from your conventional label and you intend to market both under one registration number you should submit an additional brand name for the sprayer applicator label so that it is distinct from the product name of your conventional label.

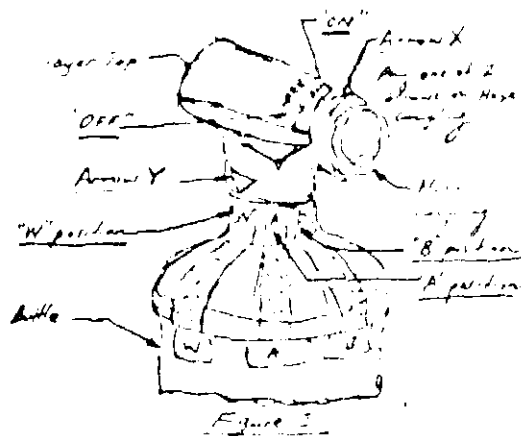

SPRAY SAFF BRAND
IN SAFETY-SEALED APPLICATOR
READY TO USE
NO MIXING - NO CHEMICAL CONTACT
EASY TO USE - ATTACH TO GARDEN HOSE,
SET AND SPRAY FOLLOWING STEPS BELOW.
See Figure 1 for Names and Markings.

1. Attach garden hose to Hose Coupling and match Arrow X to "OFF" on Sprayer Top for water off. Turn water on at faucet.
2. Push down on Sprayer Top and rotate Arrow Y from position "W" to position "A" or "B" on bottle according to chemical instructions on label.

3. To spray, turn Hose Coupling so that Arrow X points to "ON" on Sprayer Top.
4. To stop spraying, turn Hose Coupling to "OFF".
5. After spraying, turn Arrow Y to "W" position. Shut off water at faucet. Turn Arrow X to "ON" and disconnect hose.

NOTE - WATER ONLY (WITHOUT CHEMICAL) CAN BE SPRAYED WITH ARROW Y IN "W" POSITION.
IMPORTANT - TO STORE, ALWAYS TURN ARROW Y TO "W" POSITION to prevent chemical leakage. Keep out of direct sunlight and out of the reach of children. In winter, store in above freezing temperatures. Set sprayer at correct setting and spray thoroughly upper and lower leaf surfaces and other infested plant parts. Repeat treatment as needed.



HOW TO APPLY: FOR LAWNS - Measure area to be sprayed. FOR VEGETABLES AND ALL OTHER APPLICATIONS - apply as a thorough cover spray. Make application when insects first appear, or in advance of an expected infestation. Repeat application as needed or as noted in directions. Drrench lawn soil and other surfaces to be treated.
FOR PLANTS - thoroughly spray upper and lower leaves.

PROBLEM AREA

LAWNS: Bluegrass, Merion, Fescut, St. Augustine, Dichondra, Bent, Bermuda

ROSES & FLOWERS: Roses, Azaleas, Chrysanthemums

Cabbage, carrots, corn, lettuce, peas, radishes, red beets, snap beans, tomatoes, turnips

Not and pests in outside areas

A SETTING IS TO BE USED FOR THE FOLLOWING:

PESTS	RATE & AREA COVERED
Chinch Bugs, Sod Webworms, Bermuda Mites, Ants, Ticks, Earwigs, Lawn Billbugs	This bottle (1 pint) will cover 2,000 square feet
Millipedes	This bottle (1 pint) will cover 1,000 square feet.
Aphids, Mites, Leafhoppers, Thrips	Apply as a thorough spray
Cutworms (surface and subterranean), Wireworms, Root Maggots, Mole Crickets	This bottle (1 pint) covers 1,000 square feet for soil treatment.

NOTES

Thoroughly wet down grass a few hours before applying. For Lawn Billbugs, water lawn after treatment. In the North if Chinch Bugs are the only insect problem 1 pint will cover 4,000 square feet.

Spray underside of leaves. Wet plants to the dripping point.

Make application to soil surface as a broadcast spray prior to ~~spraying~~. Thoroughly spray the chemical into the top 4 - 8 inches of soil.

B SETTING IS TO BE USED FOR THE FOLLOWING:

Flies, Ants, Cockroaches, Boxelder bugs, Spider Mites, Chiggers, Fairways

Thoroughly spray window frames, doors, sills, screens, porch and patio walls and ceilings, foundations, walks, garbage cans and into cracks.
