

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

#### DISPOSAL

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

SCATTER BAIT is a white powder; odorless, non-staining. Adheres to insects, insuring long contact and kill. When properly applied, it will kill the roach population within 7 to 10 days.

Apply liberally by scattering behind and under stove, refrigerator, dishwasher, sink; around water pipes, cracks, and crevices; behind and under cabinets; along walls, radiators; underneath drawers in cabinets; around garbage cans and other trails and points of entry where roaches frequent.

To use as a baited trap, cover a slice of fresh bread with 2 teaspoonsful of powder and place bread in a high place out of reach of children and pets. Wrap and throw container and bread in garbage every 7 days.
