Directions for Use

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To control Colding Moth on Apples: Use at the rate of 8 lbs. of 50% Ryania Wettable Powder in 100 gal. of water, or 10 level tablespoons full (1-2 oz.) per gal. of water. Make up to 3 to 4 applications at 10 to 14 day intervals, beginning at petal fall for first brood. For second and third brood, make 1 to 3 applications at 10 to 14 day intervals as required. Always spray throughly to give complete coverage.

To control European Corn Borer on Corn: It is suggested as preferably to apply 50% Ryania as a dust at the rate of 30 to 40 lbs. per acre, or 1 lb. per 300 feet of row. Apply 4 times at 5 day intervals beginning when borers start hatching or feeding.

To control Citrus Thrips on Citrus: Use at the rate of 5-7 lbs. of 50% Ryania per acre in 20-100 gals. of water, with 7-15 lbs. of sugar per acre as bait. Do not overdilute, 200 or more gals. per acre, or use artificial sweeteners. By air application use 15-25 gallons of water.
